What is Fast CAT? Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line – once readied, the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow it, chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is natural grass, completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash.

Dogs must be at least twelve months of age.

Dogs may wear any type of collar except choker collars, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. No tags allowed. No exceptions. No harnesses when racing.

Bring 2 leashes: one to leave attached to the dog at the start line and one with the person catching the dog.

Unfortunately, Bitches in Season are not allowed to participate per the AKC rules. If you enter and your Bitch goes in season, please contact the trial secretary.

The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH). FORMULA:  $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$   
Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

PLEASE INDICATE YOUR DOG'S HEIGHT OR HANDICAP ON THE ENTRY FORM  
MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST HUNDRETH)

Titles are earned at specific point levels, and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points DCAT = 500 points FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Please check and confirm your dog's posted 100-yard run time the day of the event.

Flat ribbons are awarded to dogs who complete the dash and rosettes to those completing a title. These must be picked up on the day of the event. None will be mailed.

Entered dogs will be assigned an hour time slot and run position by the secretary. Each dog will run each entered event concurrently. You will need to be present 30 minutes prior to your hour time slot for roll call, dog inspection and measuring for height handicap. All dogs are expected to be current on vaccinations as required by law.

Be on time as you will not be able to test if you miss inspection and your time slot. Be present and ready with your dog for inspection 30 minutes prior to your run time.
